Muslim's claim to believe in the Torah (Torat) and the writings of David, the Psalms (Zabur) and the Gospel (Injil). However when it comes to the Bible in our hands today they consider it corrupted-and yet, Muhammad tells them to go to the Gospel.

The Qur'an tells you that:

Where it's found in the Qur'ān

Surah 5:47

• Muhammad's instructions from Allah - turn to the "Injil" (Gospel). In the seventh century in Saudi Arabia when these words were spoken, Muhammad is telling the people of the Gospel (Injil) to "judge by what God (Allāh) has revealed in the Gospel." The Injil had to have been correct at that time. Allah wouldn't have told his people to go to a corrupted book. Especially one that he knew to be corrupted and say that he has revealed that same book. That contradicts itself.

And let the **People of the Gospel judge** by what Allāh has revealed therein. And whoever does not judge by what Allāh has revealed—then it is those who are the defiantly disobedient."

Notice three things from the actual Qur'ānic text above:

Firstly, all of the verbs are in present tense—meaning they are in effect today as they were back in the seventh century. Secondly, the word "Injil" is used which means Gospel. Thirdly, the question must be asked: Is the Gospel that we have today, the same of what was in existence in the seventh century when Allah gave that command? Let's read on.

You are taught to follow the teachings of the Qur'ān. Muhammad points you to the Gospel and tells you to "Let the people of the book (Gospel – "Injil") judge by what God (Allāh) has revealed therein." (Surah 5:47)...



But there's an "Islamic dilemma:"

If Muhammad is telling the people to go to the book (the Gospel) and that book is inspired, then we are left with only two possibilities:

• Possibility No. 1: The Bible really is the inspired Word of God.

- then Jesus Christ died on the cross for sins—forgiving all of your sins
- rose from the dead—proof that God accepted His sacrifice for you
- and claimed to be God—loving you with an everlasting love

(all of which the Qur'ān teaches is false.)

... and if this first point and what it means are true, then Muhammad is a false prophet because he rejected all of these things.

Concluding then: that Muhammad is a false prophet.

OR

• **Possibility No. 2:** The Bible is not inspired and **is not** the Word of God.

... and if this second point is true, then Muhammad is a false prophet for telling the people to **go to a book that is false** and is not inspired as the Word of God which would make him to be a false prophet since the Qur'ān plainly says that Muhammad told the people to go to the book (Gospel).

Why was Muhammad reported to have said that he believed in the Torah in the possession of the Jews at his time, according to hadith: Sunan Abu Dawud Book 38, Number 4434 if it was corrupted? **Find out how much God loves you according to the Bible in the Gospels and that He has a plan for your life here and now.**
