violent, intolerant, peaceful or what?

It's very common for Muslims to speak of Islam as being a religion of peace—and yet, when one examines what their religion's holy book teaches, we see the opposite. Even though many Muslims are people of peace, does that mean that their book is one? Since most Muslims are peaceful, loving people—why do we see the opposite in the news? Rather than subjective theories, let's examine some facts about Islam's claims by quoting actual verses (ayahs) from the Qur'ān and comparing them against that of what the Bible says since the Qur'ān may be subject to scrutiny of the Gospel according to Surah (chapter) 5:47-48 in the Qur'ān.

one thing before we start

Before we start examining the Gospel (Scriptures) and the Qur'ān, I must personally express this one opinion... and that is that I believe all people are created in the image of God as the Bible teaches (Genesis 1:27). And because of that, everyone is to be treated with the highest respect possible whether or not we can agree upon each other's beliefs. The views expressed hereafter are **not to condemn, offend or hurt anyone who holds a different viewpoint than mine**, but rather to invite an open dialogue for each reader's consideration.

do we see any similarities between what the Qur'ān calls Allāh as the "Lord of the worlds" (Surah 1:2) and what the Scriptures according to the Bible call "the god of this world" found in 2 Corinthians 4:4 as stated above?

who is called "a deceiver" in the Qur'an?

Satan is described as the deceiver in the Bible (Rev. 12:9); Allāh is described as the greatest (best of) deceiver(s) in the Qur'ān (Surah 3:54); by the transitive property of equality—both Satan and Allāh are called 'deceivers.'"


Surah 3:54



54 But they (the Jews) were deceptive, and Allāh was deceptive, **for Allāh is the best of** (*planners*) **deceivers** (Wamakaroo wamakara Allāhu waAllāhu khayru almakireena)!

Surah 8:30

30 And [remember, O Muhammad], when those who disbelieved plotted against you to restrain you or kill you or evict you [from Makkah]. But they plan, and Allāh plans. And Allāh is the best of planners ('makr', deceivers).



- the word translated "plan" by most English translations of the Qur'ān is actually the Arabic word "makr" meaning "To practice deceit or guile or circumvention, practice evasion or elusion, to plot, to exercise art or craft, cunning or trickery, act with policy, practice stratagem."

who is called "deceiver" in the Bible?...

⁹ And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which **deceiveth the whole world**: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Revelation 12:9 – King James Version (KJV)

comparing above, what the Qur'an says about Allah and what the Bible says about Satan—where does that leave us?

- It may suggest that Allāh is actually Satan in disguise.
- or it is merely by pure coincidence that both Allāh of the Qur'ān and Satan as described in Scripture share the exact deceptive natures and titles of "Deceiver" and "Lord (or god) of all the worlds." (Surah 1:2)

¹⁴ And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light. ¹⁵ Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works.

2 Corinthians 11:14-15 – New King James Version (NKJV)

- The Gospel tells us that Satan will appear to us as someone or something that he is actually not (or to look like something else).
- It goes on to say that he has "counterfeit" ministers who he will empower to deceive others in the same way that he himself is a deceiver.

If you've made it this far—then you have just beaten the odds of most readers. I would encourage you to read a bit further as the information will now offer incredible insights into Islam that you may not have heard before. how does this tie-in to whether or not Islam is a religion of peace?

Islam bases its beliefs on the teachings of the Qur'ān—and look what the Qur'ān teaches about Muslims (called believers) and non-believers (the Jews and Christians) and also women

Muslims:

Surah 3:110

- 110 You are the best of peoples ever raised up for mankind...
 - Islam teaches that Muslims are above everyone else.

others (non-Muslims):

Surah 98:6

- ⁶ Verily, those who disbelieve (in the religion of Islam, the Qur'ān and the Prophet Muhammad*) from among the people of the Scripture (Jews and Christians*) and Al-Muskrikun will abide in the Fire of Hell. They are the worst of creatures.
 - meaning lower than dogs!
- * explanation in bracketed text and emphasis added for clarification—based upon the verses themselves.

Surah 5:51

51 O you who believe! do not take the Jew and the Christian for friends; they are friends of each other.

Surah 9:73

73 O Prophet! strive hard against the unbelievers and the hypocrites and be unyielding to them.

Surah 9:123

123 O you who believe! fight those of the unbelievers who are near to you and let them find in you hardness.

Surah 9:29

- 19 Fight those who believe not in Allāh nor the Last Day, nor hold that forbidden which hath been forbidden by Allāh and His Messenger, nor acknowledge the Religion of Truth, from among the People of the Book, until they pay the *Jizah* with willing submission, and feel themselves subdued.
 - in other words, until they (the People of the Book) pay...

Allāh commands Muslims to fight Jews and Christians

these verses are taken from book or chapter (Surah) nine of the Qur'ān as that is the latest or most recent "revelation" from Allāh. Apparently, due to the doctrine of "Abrogation," unlike the Bible, it is the last or most recent revelation that cancels out the former or previous verses that speak of peace to the Jews and Christians.

just a quick side note...

"Abrogation" is a key term in studying the Qur'an.

There are some peaceful, tolerant verses in the Qur'ān. But the violent, intolerant ones have abrogated them. The Qur'ān itself explains what to do with conflicting verses. If two passages conflict, it says, the one written later is better than the one written earlier. The earlier passage has been abrogated by the later one. This doctrine is explained in Surah 2:106 and also in Surah 16:101 of the Qur'ān below.

The bad news for non-Muslims is that almost all the peaceful passages were written earlier, and the intolerant, hateful and violent ones were written later.

The two key abrogation passages in the Qur'an are these:

2:106 "Whatever of Our revelations We repeal or cause to be forgotten, We will replace them with something superior or comparable. Do you not know that Allāh has power over all things? Do you not know that Allāh reigns sovereign over the heavens and earth and besides Him you have no protector or helper? Would you question your messenger as Moses was questioned in his time? Those who exchange their faith for disbelief have gone astray from the right path."

16:101 "When We exchange one verse for another, and Allāh knows best what He reveals, they say, 'You are making this up.' Most of them do not understand."

"We do not abrogate an ayat or cause it to be forgotten except that We bring forth better than it or similar to it. Do you not know that Allāh is over all things competent?" (Qur'ān 2:106).

"And when We substitute an ayat in place of an ayat—and Allāh is most knowing of what He sends down—they say, 'You, [O Muhammad], are but an inventor [of lies].' But most of them do not know." (Qur'ān 16:101)

and now, let's hear what Islam instructs about...



Muslim Statistics (Honour Violence)

A total of 428 Pakistanis comprising 260 women and 168 men were brutally killed across Pakistan in the name of honour between January 1 and August 31 in 2008.

The number of honour killings in Pakistan are estimated to be around 2,500 to 3,000 cases every year. However, the report states that a good number of such cases still go unreported or are passed off as suicides and only 25% of these are brought to justice.

According to the Human Rights Commission of Pakistan (HRCP), 260 women and 168 men have already been killed in the first eight months of 2008. Honour killings are treated as murder under Pakistan's penal code; however, the relevant law states that the family of the victim is allowed to compromise with the killer who is a close relative in most of the cases. Provisions of the Pakistani law also allow the next of kin of the victim to forgive the murderer in exchange for money. And most of the offenders continue to use this clause to escape punishment.

Sahih al-Bukhari 2658

The Prophet said: "Isn't the witness of a woman equal to half of that of a man?" The women said "Yes." He said: "This is because of the **deficiency of her mind**."

ff it kind of sounds like the Prophet just called women 'stupid!'"

... and not deserving of justice (or at least the full amount thereof) because they are **not as intelligent as men**.

Sahih Muslim 142

"O womenfolk, you should give charity and ask much forgiveness for I saw you in bulk amongst the dwellers of Hell." A wise lady among them said: "Why is it, Messenger of Allāh, that our folk are in bulk in Hell?" Upon this the Holy Prophet observed: "You curse too much and are ungrateful to your spouses. I have seen none lacking in common sense and failing in religion but (at the same time) robbing the wisdom of the wise, besides you."

so great are the women's numbers in Hell. And because they
lack both in their intellect and now as seen above, they lack
also in morality—(according to Islam), they sometimes need
to be disciplined, and let's find out how in the following verses.

ff men are in charge of women, because Allāh 'made the one of them to excel the other...'"

Surah 4:34

Men are in charge of women, because Allāh hath made the one of them to excel the other, and because they spend of their property (for the support of women). So good women are the obedient, guarding in secret that which Allāh hath guarded. As for those from whom ye fear rebellion, admonish them and banish them to beds apart, and scourge them. Then if they obey you, seek not a way against them.

Sahih al-Bukhari

(Volume 7, Book 72, Number 715) 7.72.715

A woman received worst beating from her impotent husband (Aisha: Muslim women were the worst sufferers):

Muhammad approved the beating...

even Muhammad's dearest wife, Aisha complained that the
 Muslim women received the worst beating from their husbands.

Allāh is all for the Muslim who sexually molests small child-girls

Surah (Surah) 65:4-5

For menopause women, the waiting time for divorce is three months, same for women who are yet to menstruate (i.e., a Muslim man can have sex with a girl who has not yet started menstruation—a child girl); for the pregnant women, the waiting time is until she delivers the child...

but what about Muhammad?

if Islam is a religion of peace, then is there any proof that it's founder Muhammad had ever beaten any woman as well?

Sahih al-Bukhari 7.63.181, 182

A dignified woman, Jauniyaa (a princess) was brought to Muhammad to have sex with him but she was reluctant to give herself to Muhammad; **Muhammad was angry and raised his hand to beat her...**

- which forces us to have to ask an extremely crucial...



not only had Allāh allowed Muhammad to beat women, he also allowed his messenger Muhammad to marry a little girl, Aisha, his friend Abu Bakr's daughter when she was merely six years old. Muhammad then had sex with her when she turned nine. Because Muhammad was allowed to do what he did, this same provision has also been made applicable to all Muslim men.

Sahih al-Bukhari 5.58.236

Khadijah died three years before Muhammad went to Medina; he then married Aisha when she was six and consummated the marriage when she turned nine...

what about rape?:

Surah 4:34

Also (prohibited are) women already married, except those whom your right hands possess.

- without going into a full-blown article at this time about the above verse that is speaking about sexual intercourse within the context of rape—see Abu Dawud 2150—the "except those whom your right hands possess" is referring to allowing rape among captive married women as being approved and not to be considered as adultery by the Prophet since the women are married.



according to Islam, women are stupid and immoral and you can beat them and rape them regardless if they are married or how young they might be (as Muhammad's own wife was just a girl of nine years old)."

- ⁴ "Teacher, this woman has been caught in adultery, in the very act.
- ⁵ Now in the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women (The law required that both the man and the women be stoned to death—see Leviticus 20:10); what then do You say?"...
- ⁷ (*Jesus said to them*) "He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her."...

¹⁰ Straightening up, Jesus said to her, "Woman, where are they? Did no one condemn you?" ¹¹ She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "I do not condemn you, either. Go. From now on sin no more."

John 8:1-11 – New American Standard Bible (NASB)

So what about the 10 per cent that do know their Qur'ān or who have been taught by their religious leaders, their culture and what they have been exposed to as a Muslim in mostly non-Western societies. Like any people group, society, culture—there will always be the good and the bad. We all know this, **but the question isn't about percentages, it's about a religion:** is Islam (it's book, where those who follow it, get their instruction and foundational teachings from) ...is it truly peaceful or not?

if a Muslim will be punished and replaced by Allāh,
 if they are not willing to go and fight for him.

Surah 9:123

O you who have believed, **fight those** adjacent to you of the disbelievers (*the infidels*) and let them find in you harshness. And know that Allāh is with the righteous.

- italics added for clarification—fighting those who disbelieve.

Surah 2:190-191

Fight in the way of Allāh those who fight you but do not transgress. Indeed. Allāh does not like transgressors. And **kill them wherever you overtake them** and expel them from wherever they have expelled you, and fitnah is worse than killing. And do not fight them at al-Masjid al-Haram until they fight you there. But if they fight you, **then kill them**. **Such is the recompense of the disbelievers**.

- just kill them.

Hadith 9.50

No Muslim should be killed for killing a Kafir (infidel).

- Muhammad was referring to a non-Muslim.

Surah 8:58

If you apprehend treachery from any group on the part of a people (with whom you have a treaty), retaliate by breaking off (relations) with them. The infidels should not think they can bypass (Islamic law or the punishment of Allāh). Surely they cannot escape.

 in respect (or the lack-thereof) to peace treaties and appearement with Islamic forces.

Hadith 1:25

To participate in Jihad in Allāh's cause.

- Muhammad was referring to a non-Muslim.

Surah 8:12

[Remember] when your Lord inspired to the angels, "I am with you, so strengthen those who have believed. I will cast terror into the hearts of those who disbelieved, so **strike**[them] upon the necks and strike from them every fingertip."

- more beheadings.

Hadith 9.64

No doubt I heard Allāh's messenger saying, "During the last days there will appear some young foolish people, who will say the best words, but their faith will not go beyond their throats (i.e. they will leave the faith) and will go out from their religion as an arrow goes out of the game. So, wherever you find them, kill them, for whoever kills them shall have reward on the Day of Resurrection."

- Allāh rewards those how behead unbelievers.

Muslim clerics and their apologists are saying "the command to kill non-Muslims is not for today, it was only for a certain time."

Where in the Qur'an does it say this? It does not say or teach the commands to kill the "infidels," "unbelievers," "Jews," and "Christians" was only for a previous time. Nowhere. There is proof in the Qur'an that it is actually to continue and increase.

Jesus was, and still is more than a prophet

Eventhough Muhammad is concidered to be the greatest of Prophets, Jesus Christ's birth, life, and death were all foretold, predicted, and recorded hundreds of years before the historic night of His birth in Bethlehem.



Matthew 2:16 - (NRSV)

10 Messiah's will live a perfect life, die by crucifixion – (this point is important because crucifixion had not yet been invented when the prophecy was given), resurrect from death, ascend into heaven, and sit at the right hand of God.

Prophecies:

¹⁶ Dogs have surrounded me.

A mob has encircled me.

They have pierced my hands and feet.

Psalm 22:16 – All Scriptures in prophecies point number 10 are taken from the: *Names of God Bible (NOG), with some emphasis added.*

A *miktam* [an unknown musical term] by David.

- ¹ Protect me, O *EI* [God], because I take refuge in you.
- ¹⁰ because you do not abandon my soul to the grave or allow your holy one to decay.

Psalm 16:1, 10

10 Yet, it was **Yahweh's** will to crush him with suffering. When **Yahweh** has made his life a sacrifice for our wrongdoings, he will see his descendants for many days. The will of **Yahweh** will succeed through him.

11 He will see and be satisfied because of his suffering. My righteous *Ebed* [servant] will acquit [justify] many people because of what he has learned through suffering. **He will carry their sins as a burden**.

²⁹ Brothers, I can tell you confidently that our ancestor David died and was buried and that his tomb is here to this day. ³⁰ David was a prophet and knew that God had promised with an oath that he would place one of David's descendants on his throne. ³¹ David knew that the Messiah would come back to life, and he spoke about that before it ever happened. He said that the Messiah wouldn't be left in the grave and that his body wouldn't decay.

³² "God brought this man *Yeshua* [*Jesus*] back to life. We are all witnesses to that.

Acts 2:25-32

⁹ After he had said this, he was taken to heaven.
A cloud hid him so that they could no longer see him.

Acts 1:9

³ His Son is the reflection of God's [*Sh'khinah*] glory and the exact likeness of God's being. He holds everything together through his powerful words. After he had cleansed [*made purification*] people from their sins, he received the highest position, the one next to the Father in heaven [*he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high (HaG'dulah BaM'romim)*].

my prayer for you:

Our heavenly Father,

Father, it is you whom willingly sacrificed Your Son on the Muslim's behalf. Please bring believers into the lives of those who take part in the Hajj each year and show them Your only son Jesus who both died and rose from the dead for each one.

I pray all of these things in Jesus' Holy Name and in His authority as you have instructed me to do. Thank you heavenly Father for loving Muslims and calling them to true forgiveness in Messiah Jesus and to experience His life right now.
