Two Kinds of Messianic Prophecies of the Messiah



MULTIPLE FULFILLMENT: A TWO-FOLD PROPHECY

YESHA 'YAHU 61:1a, 2a

- Isaiah 61:1a, 2a

*The Spirit of Adonai Elohim is upon me, ...to proclaim the **year of the favor** of ADONAI and the **day of vengeance** of our God.*

“The year of ADONAI’s favor” refers to Messiah’s *first* coming, whereas the “day of vengeance” refers to Messiah’s *second* coming in judgment. A first fulfillment sometimes foreshadows a second greater fulfillment.

The first set of prophecies describe a suffering Messiah who will suffer and die to atone for our sins. **The second set of prophecies** describe the victorious Messiah. Yeshua is the Messiah who came the *first time*, to suffer and die for the sins of the world. He will come again a *second time* to set up His Kingdom over the entire world. If Yeshua fulfilled the prophecies about the sufferings of the Messiah, rest assured that He will return to fulfill the prophecies about the victorious Messiah.

* "Ha" is the Hebrew word for "name." "Ha-kodesh" means holy. All of God's Names are holy and glorious. God is holy as He is perfectly pure and good, without sin; and, there is no other one above Him or equal to Him.

* Since YHVH or YHWH “THE LORD” is forbidden to be uttered except by the High Priest, in the Temple—the Hebrew letters are named, rather than how His Name sounds in respect to the holiness attached to God’s Name. **However, Coffee Scribe includes the full spelling of God’s Holy Names and the Tetragrammaton of YHWH as we do not hold to the traditions of non-Biblical, man-made rules and doctrines regarding uttering God’s Name.**
