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I am one who loves to "research." I like to look at things from different angles and search what has already been searched (re-search). In this article, I have used as many different translations of the Scriptures as possible in order to gain a broad, unprejudiced view of this topic.

what signs?

What signs must occur before the Rapture? Is there a difference in the number of signs that are given for each End Times event differentiating the Rapture from the Second Coming? Everyone agrees that there are several signs that do proceed the Second Coming, but what about the Rapture? Are there any prior signs that need to take place for the Rapture to occur?

what signs must occur before the rapture?

The Rapture

- 1 Corinthians 15:51-52 King James Version (KJV)
- ⁵¹ Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, ⁵² in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Immanence

and "at any moment!":

If there were any such signs needed, then please consider what the Bible has to say about waiting and His imminent return as follows:

Jesus told His Disciples to continuously wait for Him—implying

immanence which refers to being "near," "next," forthcoming,"

- 1 Thessalonians 1:10 English Standard Version (ESV)
- 10 ...and to **wait for** his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.

Continuously Wait

The word for "wait" in verse 10 above is the greek word "anamenein" which means to **continuously wait**, abide, tarry, and expect. The Father's actions are swift, discerning, and decisive. He doesn't waist even a second. God does not always move at our frantic pace. We are too often double espresso followers of a decaf Sovereign and when it comes to waiting, He holds the sands of time. This same word to continuously wait and expect is also used in verse 2 below:

1 Thessalonians 1:2 - Amplified Bible (AMP)

² We give thanks to God always for all of you, **continually** mentioning you in our prayers;

So concerning imminency and waiting, we are to continuously wait for Christ—meaning He can come at any moment (The Rapture).

Right Outside the Door

James 5:9 - The Voice (VOICE)

⁹ Brothers and sisters, don't waste your breath complaining about one another. If you judge others, you will be judged yourself. Be very careful! You will face the one true Judge who is **right outside the door**.

Christ can step through the door from heaven at any moment. There are no signs that need to proceed the Rapture unlike His Second Coming.

A Comparison: The Rapture vs. the Second Coming

one: signs

Rapture

Imminent event with **no signs** given (John 14:1-3; 1 Corinthians 15:50-55; 1 Thessalonians 1:10; 4:13-18; 5:9; 2 Thessalonians 2:1)

Second Coming

Proceeded by **many signs** (Matthew 24:1-31; Revelation 6:1 - Revelation 18:24)

two: when

Rapture

It occurs **before** the Tribulation (Luke 21:36)

Second Coming

It occurs **after** the Tribulation (Matthew 24:29-30)

three: who

Rapture

Christ comes **for** His own (John 14:3)

Second Coming

Christ comes with His own (Revelation 19:14)

four: where

Rapture

Christ **takes** the Saints to heaven (John 14:3)

Second Coming

Christ **brings** the Saints back to earth (Zechariah 14:4-5; Revelation 19:14)

five: how

Rapture

Christ comes to the **air** (1 Thessalonians 4:17)

Second Coming

Christ comes to the **earth** (Revelation 1:7)



Rapture

Only His own see Him (1 Corinthians 15:52

Second Coming

Every eye will see Him (Revelation 1:7)

seven: hope

Rapture

It is the "blessed hope" of the Church (Titus 2:13)

Second Coming

It is the great day of His wrath (Revelation 19:15)

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
