The "Feasts of the LORD" are "Appointed Times" that have been instituted by Adonai (G-d) as times of great significance to mankind and the history / future of the world

What may have been the Significance Regarding this latest Lunar Tetrad?

14 May 1948 Israel became a nation which preceded a recent lunar tetrad period which occurred between 1949 to 1950. Exactly 19 years from that tetrad period was another tetrad which was from 1967 to 1968 during the Six-Day War when Jerusalem became under Jewish control for the first time in 2000 years. Almost 48 years from that last lunar tetrad (47 years, 11 months, 11 days) we have entered into an this latest lunar tetrad period.

Some had speculate that this 2014 to 2015 lunar tetrad once again may had been of great significance to the world events surrounding Israel. No one was able to accurately predict such historic events, but according to Biblical texts, we have been told to "watch" as signs like these are displayed in the sky according to Revelation 6:12 which says:

12 Then I watched as He broke the sixth seal, and there was a great earthquake, the sun turned black as sackcloth worn in mourning, and the full moon became blood-red. – Complete Jewish Bible

Tishri 1

Feasts of Trumpets

According to Jewish tradition, on this day the gates of heaven are opened (Rev. 3:7-11). It is known as "A DAY AND HOUR NO MAN KNOWS." During this time, the wheat is brought into the threshing floor and separated from the chaff. This day points to the announcement of Yeshua's (Jesus') Second Coming and the Resurrection of the Saints (1 Thess. 4:16-17).

Tishri 10

Day of Atonement – Judgment Day or The Day of the LORD

This is the day the chaff is burned up on the threshing floor on the temple mount and the day the gates of heaven are closed (Rev. 3:7-11). This day may represent the Tribulation. Just as Moses came down the mountain on the Day of Atonement, so shall be the Second Coming of Messiah be: Z'kharyah (Zechariah) 14:4.
