
## **S ESSENTIAL BIBLE VERSES NEEDED FOR EVANGELISM**





## Christian - here's how you can share the gospel with absolutely anyone

Most people believe that they can not know if they will make it to heaven because they do not know if their *"good deeds outweigh their bad ones"*—unlike Christ's love that has no strings attached what-so-ever for complete and total forgiveness of sin.\*

What God's Word (the Bible) says about your 'sin charges' (what you have owing against you) and what God did to fix it:

For all have sinned and fall short of [or lack] the glory of God;
Romans 3:23 – Christian Standard Bible (CSB)

\* **Sin is:** acting or behaving in a way that does not conform with God's character or commands. It is about crossing lines that have been laid down for us by God. Sin is thus an act of rebellion and distrust. It is us saying to God: "You don't get to make the rules! I am capable of deciding right and wrong for myself, my way!"

## THE SIN EFFECT

Sin leads to death in terms of the decline of human society. When you reject the good commands of God you enter into the realm of violence, greed, theft, hatred, strife, murder, and war which result in great suffering and loss for human beings. Sin diminishes you; deceives you; robs you of your original design and worth, and leads you to spiritual death which separates you from experiencing God and His love.

For **the wages of sin is death**, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. – Romans 6:23 (CSB)

## GOD'S SOLUTION WHAT JESUS DID ON YOUR BEHALF

The life and death of Jesus has provided a way for you to have a 'just peace' with God. It has the power to remove forever the offense of human sin. Because of who Jesus was—the perfect, sinless Son of God; Jesus could do something that no one else was able to do. He could die for the sins of the world. Because He never sinned, His sacrifice was freely applied to all who take hold of it in faith, paying for your sin debt.

<sup>31</sup> They said, **'Believe in the Lord Jesus**, and you will be saved—you and your household.' – Acts 16:30-31 (CSB)

If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> One believes with the heart, resulting in righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, resulting in salvation. – Romans 10:9-10 (CSB)

For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. - Romans 10:13 (CSB)

Jesus died for you by taking your sins with Him to the grave—He buried your sins there forever, never to be counted against you ever again. Jesus rose from the dead—proving that God has forgiven your sins totally, completely, and forever. Pray (talking) to Him and ask Him to forgive your sins TODAY!
